This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, store, and protect your personal information when you visit our website or interact with us.

1. Information We Collect

We may collect and process the following types of personal data:

- Accounting, legal, or regulatory authorities (when required by law)

All third parties are required to handle your data securely and in compliance with applicable data protection laws.

We retain personal data only for as long as necessary to fulfill the purposes outlined in this Privacy Policy, or as required by applicable laws and regulations.

6. Data Security

We implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect your personal data against unauthorized access, loss, misuse, or disclosure.
